

Dear Member,

You may be aware of the new **General Data Protection Regulation**, regarding personal data 'GDPR' which is designed to protect your personal data. More information can be obtained at <https://ico.org.uk/for-organisations/guide-to-the-general-data-protection-regulation-gdpr/>

This regulation legislation requires us to inform you of the personal data we have to manage the SSWCS membership, and the dog shows we hold as a club and for you to request the deletion of your personal data that we hold.

You can request the deletion of your personal data by emailing/writing to the Secretary.

The member's personal data we retain:

- Your name
- Your email address (if supplied)
- Your address
- Amount(s) of fees paid. (Membership, Entry fees, Sponsorships/Donations, may paid by the club)
- Breed of dog(s)
- Awards received at our shows

This information is kept and managed by the Secretary on a spread sheet on a password protected personal computer.

Communication to the membership is via email – for those whose email addresses we hold, also on the society's website and Facebook pages.

When emails are sent to the membership, we send a blind circulation method, so that email addresses are kept private and are not shared. We will not sell or exchange your personal data without your permission.
